Located near downtown Los Angeles, just north of China Town, the Church was founded in 1904 "to produce good Catholics according to Italian tradition." Since then, the Church has been an integral part of Los Angeles City history. It has helped preserve the Italian heritage of many Los Angeles residents for over one hundred years, hosting numerous societies dedicated to Italian customs and Saints, such as the Society of Canneto (established 1934), the Society of Maria Santissima di Constantinopoli (established 1935), the San Trifone Society (established 1936), the Saint Anthony of Padua Society (established 1939), as well as the Italian Catholic Federation.

Every March 19, the Church also hosts the traditional Sicilian celebration of Saint Joseph's Table, in the adjoining Casa Italiana.
